<p><b>Growth Habit Key:</b>  <b>Determinate habit (D):</b> Bush type growth. The plant stops growing when the fruit sets. The majority of fruit develop at the same time which is good for canning.</p> <p><b>Indeterminate habit (I):</b> Vine type growth. Best grown with stakes or in cages. Fruit develops continuously throughout the season.</p>			<p><b>Disease Resistance Key:</b>  <b>V</b> - Resistant to Verticillium Wilt;  <b>F</b> - Resistant to Fusarium Wilt;  <b>FF</b> - Races 1 &amp; 2; N-Resistant to Nematodes;  <b>T</b> - Resistant to Tobacco Mosaic Virus;  <b>A</b> - Resistant to Alternaria Stem canker;  <b>St</b> - Resistant to Stemphylium Gray Leaf Spot;  <b>TSWV</b> - Resistant to Tomato Spotted Wilt Virus</p>

Arkansas Marvel	Large	I	Heirloom	Vigorous, big tomato plants that yield moderate to heavy crops of 4-inch, 1 lb., meaty, yellow-orange beefsteak tomatoes with red marbling with a gush of wonderful sweet, well-balanced tomato flavors. A good salad tomato or sliced thick in sandwiches. Matures in 100 days.	
Camp Joy	Cherry	I	Heirloom	Heavy bearing heirloom variety that offers an abundance of luscious 1" fruit with huge, well-balanced, sweet tomato flavors. Strong disease resistant. Perfect for snacking or salads. Matures in 81 days	
Celebrity	Medium	Semi-D	VFFNTASt	This AAS Award Winner established a new standard for main-crop hybrids requiring multiple disease resistance. Highly adaptable from Canada to the South. Medium sized, globe-shaped fruits are crack-resistant and average 7 oz. Matures in 70 days.	
Champion 2	Large	I	VFFNTA	Features more disease resistance while maintaining the same delicious flavor and timing. Delivers high yields of meaty, 6 to 7 oz. fruits. Intermediate resistance to Yellow Leaf Curl Virus. Matures in 62-65 days	
Chocolate Stripes	Very large	I	Heirloom	Very large, regular-leaf tomato plants that yield a plentiful crop of 3-4 inch, mahogany colored with dark, olive green-striping (similar to black zebra). Fruits have delicious, complex, rich, sweet, earthy tomato flavors. A great sandwich tomato and salad tomato. Matures in 79 days.	
Dona	Small	I	VFFNT	A slightly flattened, almost seedless, round tomato with a sweet/acid balance. The heavily producing plants yield 6 ounce, juicy fruits that are smooth, meaty, and deep-red in hue. Good disease resistance. Matures in 75 days	
Early Girl	Medium	I	VFF	Matures extra-early in the season! Meaty, red fruits, 4 to 6 oz., slightly flattened and bright crimson throughout. Very appealing, with firm texture and blemish-resistant skin. Heavy yields on hardy vines. Matures in 57 Days.	

German Giant	Large	I	Heirloom	Abundant crop of very large, 2 lb. beautiful, deep-pink tomatoes that are similar to the famed Brandywine but matures earlier. Full of rich, complex, sweet flavors. Matures in 85 days.
German Johnson	Large	I	Heirloom	A large, prolific plant that produces huge, pink, beefsteak type tomatoes often more than 1-pound. The flavor is excellent, a wonderful tomato. Matures in 78 days.
Roma	Roma	D	VFA	Roma is considered to be the most well-known paste-type tomato, perfect for sauces, pastes and ketchup. Its heavy crops of bright red, pear-shaped fruits are nice and meaty, with very few seeds. Matures in 75 days.
Sun Gold	Cherry	I	VFNT	Very sweet, bright orange cherry tomatoes taste not just sugary but also fruity and delicious. Vigorous growers, these tall plants bear long clusters of fruit. Matures in 57 days.

## Peppers

Variety	Type	Notes
Ancho San Martin Hybrid	Poblano	Mild poblano chile rellano type, early to maturity and improved setting capabilities. Called "Ancho" when dried, the dark green, 5 1/2" fruits are a favorite for roasting. One of the mildest chiles, typically just 500 to 1000 Scovilles, although they sometimes register slightly hotter. A better yielder than most others of its type. Matures in 75 days.
Banana Bill	Sweet Banana	A sweet banana pepper with long, tapered fruits, 6" long by 1" across at the top. Bright and attractive with light yellow color that matures to red. Thick-walled and excellent flavor that's especially sweet at the red stage. High-yielding and disease resistant. Matures in 65 days.
Big Bertha Hybrid	Sweet Bell	Extra-large, mostly 4-lobed, fruits mature up to a full 7" long by 3-1/2" across, turning deep green to red, with full-season fruiting. Resists Tobacco Mosaic. Upright plants grow 25 to 30". Matures in 70 Days.
Cherry Bomb Hybrid	Hot Cherry	First hybrid hot cherry, with 30-50 percent greater yield. Used both green and red for canning and pickling. Medium-hot, 2-1/2" by 1-1/2" fruits are thick-walled. Resists Tobacco Mosaic. Matures in 65 days.
Golden Treasure		Italian heirloom variety, excellent for frying, roasting and fresh eating. Long, 9" fruits ripen from green to shiny yellow. Sweet flavor with medium thick flesh and tender skin. Matures in 80 days.
Gypsy	Sweet Italian	AAS Winner. Extremely early, heavy producer of wedge-shaped, tasty peppers with sturdy walls and crunchy, firm, sweet, flesh. A very reliable yielder, all season long. Plants grow to 18 inches tall. Suitable for containers. Highly disease resistant, Tobacco Mosaic Virus resistant. Yellow-Green to Orange-Red. Matures in 60 days.
Mucho Nacho	Hot Jalapeno	Big powerful taste. Jumbo peppers are 4" long, fatter & a bit hotter than regular jalapenos. Vigorous, high yield, early maturing plants. Matures in 68-70 days.
